REPORT

- Covered:
 - The current electricity market monitoring in Baltic States (in line with the Directive 2009/72/EC)
 - Shortcomings of the present market monitoring and issues to be solved
 - Proposal for the principles and outcome of the Common Baltic Electricity Market Monitoring Rules



Issues

- Need to be harmonised:
 1. Wholesale market and PX monitoring, taking into account the REMIT
 2. Retail market monitoring, taking into account the indicators of National Reports to EC and Guidelines of Good Practice Indicators for Retail Market Monitoring
 3. The indicators and data collection on capacity allocation and congestion management on interconnections, if needed
 4. Balancing market monitoring with the respective Nordic legal acts



Outcome

- Data for NRAs for market analyze to define shortcomings
- Data for NRAs for the annual reports to EC
- Constant update in understandable and comparable form
- Common annual Baltic Electricity Market Report with main characteristic indicators



Procedures and publishing

- Rules specify submission by whom and what data
- Confidentiality aspects
- Energy Regulators websites
